Step 6: Ban the Boring Two Stars and a Wish

Two Stars

Start by telling the writer two things they are doing right! For example, you might say, 'Your beginning was snappy and really grabbed my attention' and 'Using a quotation here to convey the information was a great idea'.



... and a Wish

Then suggest how the writer could make improvements. For example, you might say, 'Switching these body paragraphs around would build tension and help set up the Ending with Impact'.
